### *A Study of God*

Our second Home Bible Study for 2017 was this past Tuesday night and our topic was a study of God. In the “short” time we had, there was no way we could cover every aspect of such a study. We began by focusing on Pharaoh’s question, “Who is the Lord...” Ex. 5:2 and followed it with what this means to each of us “personally.” John 17:3 Jesus says, “This is eternal life, that they may know God, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom God sent.” We spent the rest of our time discussing what it means to “know” God.

We found that to know God is much more than facts or simple knowledge, but rather indicative of a personal relationship with God.

God’s power and understanding our emphasized in

Psalms 147:4-5. God counts the stars and gives them all names. Man has determined that the nearest star is 4.27 light years from earth. Light travels at 186,000 miles per second. Our galaxy, the Milky Way is estimated to have 100 billion stars and it is further estimated that there are more than 100 billion other galaxies in the universe. The most distant star in the Milky Way is estimated to be 220,000 light years away. The most distant star “known” is 140 million light years away!! (read Gen. 1:14-17) Did you notice the end of verse 17 “God made the stars also.” Amazing!! Princeton Astronomer Henry Russell had just finished his lecture and a woman asked, “If the world is so little, and the universe so great, how can we believe that God pays any attention to us?” Dr. Russell replied, “That depends, madam, entirely on how big a God you believe in.”

Psalm 147:1-3, is clear that the same God who has such power and understanding (i.e. stars), “heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.” We stand in awe of such power and understanding that can create, number and name all the stars – but we do not KNOW GOD until we “KNOW” this personal relationship that “heals” – such tenderness and mercy from one with such power and understanding should at once “humble” us and fill us with overwhelming thanksgiving. Beyond this it should establish a “relationship” of love and trust. I John 4:19 reminds us that “We love God, because He first loved us.” That great tenderness, gentleness and love is seen in many ways, but the giving of His only begotten Son (John 3:16; Romans 5:8) stands clear as the epitome of the answer to our question, “Who is the Lord?”

Do you know God? Do you have a personal relationship with God that is based upon WHO HE IS AND WHAT HE HAS DONE – FOR YOU? This relationship must be based upon His boundless, unselfish, and sacrificial love. Paul stated the relationship this way (note the personal aspect and the relationship it maintains): “I am crucified with Christ, nevertheless, I live, yet not I, but Christ lives in me and the life that I now live in the flesh, I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved ME and gave Himself for Me.” Gal. 2:20
