Who May Marry?

Divorce is rampant in our country, up 500% over the last 50 years. 60 years ago, 1 in 8 marriages ended in divorce. Today, it is 1 out of every 2. If we marry someone we date, and we do, we need to consider “dating” the first critical step of a good marriage.

So who may marry and be pleasing in the sight of God in that marriage? What constitutes a scriptural marriage according to God’s word?

Let’s begin by approaching our topic from the negative perspective.

Marriage can be broken for only 3 “scriptural” reasons:

1. Death of wife or husband.

“For the woman which hath a husband is bound by the law to her husband as long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband.”

Romans 7:2

It should be noted that even these relationships may have been marked by sin. In such cases, repentance must take place. In other words, death alone may not be sufficient in some cases.

2. Sexual immorality can also sever the marriage.

“And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication and shall marry another, commiteth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery.” Matt. 19:9

3. The Unbeliever chooses to leave.

“If the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or sister is not under bondage in such cases.” (I Cor. 7:15).

This does not mean they are no longer married, but are bound to the Lord first. The believer must remain unmarried or be reconciled to their spouse.

“And unto the married I command, yet not I, but the Lord, Let not the wife depart from her husband: But and if she depart, let her remain unmarried, or be reconciled to her husband: and let not the husband put away his wife.” I Cor. 7:10-11

WHO MAY MARRY SCRIPTURALLY?

1. One who has never been married.
2. One whose spouse has died.
3. One who is “Scripturally” divorced.
(They were the innocent party that put away their mate for the cause of fornication – illicit sexual activities)

“The Pharisees also came unto Him, tempting Him, and saying unto Him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause? And He answered and said unto them, **Have ye not read, that He which made them at the beginning made them male and female, And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.** They say unto Him, Why did Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement, and to put her away? He saith unto them, **Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so. And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery.** His disciples say unto Him, If the case of the man be so with his wife, it is not good to marry. But He said unto them, **All men cannot receive this saying, save they to whom it is given. For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from thier mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive it let him receive it.**
