Turning the World Upside Down

Some Jews who were envious of the preaching of the Gospel took evil men and led an assault on Jason’s home in Acts 17:1-5. They would cry out in the next verse to the rulers of the city that, “these who have turned the world upside down have come here too.”

Would and could such an accusation be made against us?

Each of us must consider our attitudes as we strive to serve the Lord. What will you do differently in 2018 to advance the Kingdom of our Lord? What part will you play in this local congregation? Will you be so fervent in your zeal for Christ and His Kingdom that those who know you would “accuse” you of turning the world upside down?

“Attitude” is everything!! (Prov. 4:23; 23:7). This lesson was conveyed to me by a great mentor in my life when he told me – “It is not what the Bible says, but how people feel about what it says.”

I can assure you he meant no disrespect to God’s Word but had a keen insight as to why people do what they do and that was his emphasis. I have come to realize that we (with few exceptions) choose to do just what we WANT TO DO...

I am convinced we have all that we need to worship God in spirit and in truth (John 4:24). I am confident that we could give book, chapter and verse for all we are doing (Truth). Real change will be seen in our lives when we get our attitudes right with God (our “spirit”). The church at Ephesus was well established and had some good qualities, but they were told “you have left your first love” (Rev. 2:1-4). There answer is our answer to get our attitudes and lives corrected: Remember – Repent and Do the First Works (vs. 5). In other words, fall in love again – focus on God’s love for you, His Grace toward you (remember what you were? Eph. 2:1-7) and His kindnesses to you...

In addition to our Annual Goals for 2018 let’s determine to do things differently this year. Can you make this vow?
