## **BETTER COVENANT OF BETTER PROMISES**

**There is something about someone saying, "Now this is the main point of the things we are saying!" (Heb. 8:1). The writer of the Hebrew letter is ending his discussion of the priesthood of Jesus Christ that he began in chapter four verse fourteen when he wrote: "Seeing then that we have a great High Priest Who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession."**

**So our High Priest Jesus Christ is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens (8:1)! He is a Minister of the sanctuary and the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man (vs. 2). The conclusion is that Jesus is not a priest like the priests on earth who serve according to the Levitical priesthood in that He is a Mediator of a better covenant, and that covenant is based on better promises (vs.6).**

## **OPPORTUNITIES TO STUDY**

**Determine right now that you will be at every opportunity to study God's word. There are the weekly scheduled classes on Sunday morning and Wednesday evening. In addition, we have several "Home Bible Studies" throughout the year!!**

**Here are the Auditorium Classes:**

**Sunday Morning "Epistles of John"  
(currently in I John 3)**

**Wednesday Evening "Hebrews"  
(currently in Hebrews 2:5-18)**

**God gave the Hebrews a pattern through the Old Covenant which served as a copy and shadow of the heavenly things. Be reminded that Moses built the tabernacle of the Old Testament according to the pattern shown him on the mountain (vs. 5).**

**Consider carefully the pattern of the heavenly tabernacle built by Jesus Christ Who obtained a more excellent ministry than that of the first covenant (vss. 6, 7). The first covenant was not faultless while the second is perfect in the Lord Jesus (vs. 7).**

**An evaluation of a prophecy of Jeremiah will make the Hebrew writer's point. It will be a new covenant not according to the covenant made with the fathers who were led out of the land of Egypt (vss. 8, 9). The new covenant will be written in their minds and in their hearts (vs. 10).**

**The heavenly Father says that He will be their God and they will be His people in that they will know the Lord from the least to the greatest of them. He will be merciful to their unrighteousness and their sins and lawless deeds will be remembered no more (vss. 11-13). The covenant and promises are better in the New Covenant because they are based on the sacrifice of Jesus Christ rather than the animals of the Old Covenant (Heb. 10:1-4).**

**The first covenant is made obsolete because God proclaims, "A new covenant!" (Heb. 8:13; 10:9). In Jesus Christ all Christians are people of God in a better covenant of better promises! As Christians we serve in a sanctuary and true tabernacle which the Lord erected according to the Father's pattern!**
